

Supplier Flow-Down Clauses

The contract clauses listed below apply to all purchase orders issued from Sagotech Corporation unless exempted by the actual clause itself, or as otherwise agreed with Sagotech in writing. In select cases, limitations on the flow-down applicability are summarized in the table. These are not a replacement for the full detail of the flow-down applicability. Regulation numbers typically refer to FAR or DFAR clauses.
